Week 6, Sunday (February 1) Lev 11-14

1. Among land animals, what two things would determine if an animal is clean or not? cloven hooves, chewing the cud
2. Among water creatures, what two things determine if the creature is clean and ok to eat? fins, scales
3. Which flying insects with four feet were clean to eat? locust, cricket, grasshopper
4. What two things determine if a sore may be leprous? raw flesh, hair on sore turned white and sore deeper than the skin
5. Was a man considered unclean for going bald? NO
6. Where did the leprosy dwell? alone, outside the camp
7. What must the "cured" leper do before coming into the camp (Lev. 14:8)? wash his clothes, shave off all his hair, take a bath
What must he do before entering his own tent in the camp? stay outside his tent seven days
8. Could a house have leprosy? YES

Week 6, Monday (February 2) Lev 15-17

9. What animal sacrifices must take place before Aaron enters into the Lord's presence? 1 bull & 2 goats
10. On what day of the year/month was the priest to make atonement for Israel? 10 day of the 7th month
11. How often was the priest to make atonement for Israel? once a year
12. The life of all flesh is in its blood. What makes atonement for the soul? blood

Week 6, Tuesday (February 3) Lev 18-20

13. Lev. 18:22 - What does God call "an abomination"? male lying with a male
14. Lev. 18:23 - What does God call "perversion"? mating with an animal
15. Why was the land of Canaan "defiled", per Lev. 18:27? because the males were lying with the males and they were mating with an & animal v.22 & 23
16. Why were the Israelites commanded not to fully harvest their crops, fields and vineyards? they were to leave it for the poor and the stranger
17. What two things are forbidden by God in Lev. 19:28? cuttings and tattoo marks

18. According to Lev. 19:32, you should honor *the presence of an old man* and fear *God*.
19. According to Lev. 20:10, what should happen to the man who commits adultery and the woman with whom he commits adultery? *put to death*
20. What did God say should happen to the person who had male homosexual sex, incest, or the man or woman who mated with an animal? *put to death*

27. On what day was the Lord's Passover? *14th day of 1st month at twilight*
28. How many days after the day after the Lord's Passover (?) was the feast of weeks? *50 days*
29. According to Lev. 23:43, why did the Lord command the Israelites to dwell in booths? *so that generations will know that God made them dwell in booths when brought out of Egypt*
30. What two gifts of the Magi ("wise men") are mentioned in Lev. 24:6-7? *gold, frankincense*
31. Were there any Egyptians among the Israelites (Lev. 24:10)? *YES*

33. To what did each Israelite return in the year of Jubilee? *to his possession (property)*
34. What possession was NOT released in the year of Jubilee, according to Lev. 25:29-30? *a house in a walled city*

 Males, 20-60 *50 shekels* Females, 20-60 *30 shekels*
 Males, 5-20 *20 shekels* Females, 5-20 *10 shekels*
 Males, 1 mo. to 5 *5 shekels* Females, 1 mo. to 5 *3 shekels*
 Males, 60+ *15 shekels* Females, 60+ *10 shekels*
