2. Who was judge in Israel at the time? Deborah Who did she send against Jabin's army? Barak How many and from which tribes came out against Jabin's army? 10,000; Naphtali, Zebulun
3. Who killed Sisera, commander of Canaan's army, and how? Jael; drove a peg through his temple
4. How long did the land then have rest? 40 years
5. How long did Midian prevail against Israel? 7 years
6. Whom did the angel of the Lord appoint to be Israel's next judge? Gideon Of what tribe was he (Judges 6:15)? Manasseh Did he know he was speaking with an angel of the Lord? NO

10. With what 3 items were Gideon's soldiers armed? trumpet, torch, empty pitcher
11. Who killed the Midianites (Judges 7:22)? God
