Week 24, Sunday (Jun 7) Psalm 34-36

- 1. (34:1) Abimelech is the name of several Philistine kings (like the use of the word Pharoah). Which king, according to I Sam. 21:12-15, is David writing this Psalm about? *Achish king of Gath*
- 2. What will those who seek the Lord not lack? *any good thing* 34:10
- 3. Many *are* the <u>afflictions</u> of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all. <u>34:19</u>
- 4. (35:1) Who is David referring to in this Psalm? *his enemies*
- 5. When David was having adversity, what did his enemies do? rejoiced and gathered together 35:15
- 6. (36:2) What does the wicked flatter himself with? *his own eyes*
- 7. The words of a wicked man's mouth are *wickedness and deceit 36:3*
- 8. God's mercy and judgments reach from the <u>heaven</u> to the <u>great deep. 36:5,6</u>

Week 24, Monday (Jun 8) Psalm 37-39

- 9. (37:2) Why should we not be envious of the workers of iniquity? they shall be cut down like grass, and whither as the green herb
- 10. What should we cease and forsake? *anger*, *wrath* 37:8
- 11. According to 37:21, what should the righteous do? *show mercy, gives*
- 12. But the salvation of righteousness is from the *Lord 37:39*
- 13. In Psalm 38:3, why is David feeling so badly? *his sin*
- 14. According to 38:21, what was David afraid that God would do? forsake him
- 15. "LORD, make me to know <u>my end</u>, And what is the measure of <u>of my days</u>, That I may know <u>how</u> <u>frail I am. 39:4</u>
- 16. Why do you think "every man at his best state is but vapor"? we are not long on this earth 39:5, 11

Week 24, Tuesday (Jun 9) Psalm 40-43

- 17. (40:4) Blessed *is* that man who makes the LORD his *trust*, And does not *respect* the proud, nor such as turn aside to *lies*.
- 18. God's wonderful works are more than can be *numbered*. 40:5
- 19. (40:16) All who seek God should *rejoice and be glad*.

- 20. (41:1, 2) Why does David say "Blessed is he who considers the poor"? he will deliver him in time of trouble,

 preserve him and keep alive, and he will be on the earth
- 21. Who does David want to not triumph over him? *his enemies.* 41:11
- 22. (42:1) Should our soul want for God as the deer pants for water? yes
- 23. According to Numbers 26:10 what happened to Korah? swallowed up by the earth
- 24. The LORD will command His *loving kindness* in the daytime, And in the night His song shall be with me-- A prayer to the God of my life. *42:8*
- 25. In 43:1, who do the sons of Korah want to be delivered from? *deceitful and unjust man*

Week 24, Wednesday (Jun 10) Psalm 44-46

- 26. T F The Israelites gained possession of the land by their own hand. (44:3) FALSE
- 27. T F Their bow and their sword saved them. FALSE 44:6
- According to 44:21, what does God know? secrets of the heart
- 29. (45:7) God loves <u>righteousness</u> and hates <u>wickedness</u>

- 31. How long shall the people praise God? *forever and ever 45:17*
- 32. (46:1) God is our *refuge* and *strength*. A very present help in *trouble*

Week 24, Thursday (Jun 11) Psalm 47-49

- 51. Besides telling the King where David fled, what other thing did Doeg do (I Sam. 22:18)? *he killed 85 priests*
- 52. Instead of God, what did Doeg trust in? the abundance of his riches 52:7

Week 24, Saturday (Jun 13) Psalm 53-56

- 53. What has the fool said in his heart? "There is no God" 53:1
- 54. According to David, how many people are doing good? *none* 53:1
- 55. (54:1) Who went to Saul and told him that David was hiding with them? *the Ziphites*
- 56. Who does David say is his helper? *God 54:4*
- 57. Who is the Lord with? "those who uphold my life" 54:4
