Week 35, Sunday (Aug 23) Jer 18-20

1. Jer 18:6 What is the significance of the potter versus the clay? *God is the potter, we are the clay*
2. T F Since Jeremiah was God's prophet, his life was not in danger. *False 18:18*
3. In whose presence did Jeremiah break a flask and prophesy the coming calamity in Judah? (Jer. 19:1,10) *some of the elders and some of the prophets*
4. Why would they eat their children and friends? *the seige & desperation caused by their enemies 19:9*
5. Who struck and shackled Jeremiah because of these prophecies (Jer. 20:1-2)? *Pashur the priest and governor*
6. The captor of Judah, named in Jer. 20:4, is: *Babylon*
7. What happened when Jeremiah tried not to prophesy for the Lord (Jer. 20:9)? *His word was in his heart like a burning fire, shut up in his bones. He was weary of holding back and could not*

Week 35, Monday (Aug 24) Jer 21-23

8. What did Jeremiah recommend to save one's life from the warring Babylonians (Jer. 21:8-9)? *defect to the enemy, flee the city*
9. "But I will *punish* you according to the *fruit of your doings*," says the LORD; "I will *kindle* a fire in its *forest* and it shall *devour* all things around it." *21:14*
10. To whom (Jer. 22:1) did the Lord tell Jeremiah to prophesy concerning the son of Josiah? *King of Judah*
11. What does the Lord say was "knowing Me", according to Jer. 22:15-16? *doing justice and righteousness, judging the poor and needy*
12. Against whom were the woes in Jer. 23 directed? *the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture*
13. According to Jer. 23:33-40, for what specific phrase would the Lord punish the false prophets everlastingly? "The *oracle* of the *Lord.*"

Week 35, Tuesday (Aug 25) Jer 24-27

14. In Jer. 24, who were like the "good figs"? *Judah* Who were like the "bad figs"? *Zedekiah and his princes*
15. According to Jer. 25:3, for how long had the word of God come to Jeremiah as of the 4th year of the reign of Jehoiakim? *23 years*
16. How long would Judah serve the king of Babylon (Jer. 25:11)? *70 years*
17. What would the Lord do after that time (Jer. 25:12-13)? *punish the king of Babylon and the Chaldeans*

21. What "prop" did the Lord use to encourage the nations to submit to Babylon (Jer. 27:2,11)? *bonds and yokes*

Week 35, Wednesday (Aug 26) Jer 28-30

23. Who prophesied impending doom for Babylon and peace for Judah (Jer. 28:1)? *Hananiah the son of Azur*

26. To whom (Jer. 29:1) was Jeremiah's letter in Jer. 29 addressed? *to the remainder of the elders who were carried away captive, to the priests, the prophets and all the people*

Week 35, Thursday (Aug 27) Jer 31-33

35. What did Jeremiah charge him to do with the deed (Jer. 32:14)? *put them in an earthen vessel that they might last for many days*
