## Dec 6-12

### Week 45, Sunday (Dec 6) Phil 2-4

1. Paul said that every knee should bow, of those in heaven and of those on earth and of those under the earth 2:10
2. He also told the Philippians to "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling 2:12
3. Who did Paul want to send to Philippi (Phil. 2:19)? Timothy Whom did he send (Phil. 2:25)? Epaphroditus
4. According to Phil. 3:5, Paul was of the tribe of Benjamin concerning the law, a Pharisee persecuting the church in his zeal.
5. Paul said, "our citizenship is in heaven". (Phil. 3:20)
6. Phil. 4:4 - "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say rejoice!"
7. What should we be anxious for? nothing 4:6
8. "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." 4:13

### Week 50, Monday (Dec 7) Col 1-3

9. Who wrote Colossians (Col. 1:1) and to whom (Col. 1:2)? Paul, faithful brethren in Colosse
10. What things were created by and for Christ? all things 1:16
11. What does Paul say is "Christ's body"? the church 1:24
12. (Col. 2:10) Christ is the head of all principality and power
13. What did Christ nail to the cross in Col. 2:14? the handwriting of the requirement that was against us
14. What are a shadow of things to come? festivals, new moons, sabbaths 2:16,17
15. Where is Christ? above, sitting at the right hand of God 3:1
16. What should we put off, since we are a new man? anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language and lying Col 3:8-10
17. Whatever we do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus 3:17

### Week 50, Tuesday (Dec 8) Col 4, I Thess 1-3

18. Col. 4:6 - "Let your speech always be with grace seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.
19. Who did Paul send with Tychicus to Colosse? Onesimus 4:9
20. What other epistle were the Colossians to read besides the one Paul wrote to them? Laodicea's epistle 4:16

21. Where did the word of the Lord sound forth? From Thessalonica to *Macedonia, Achaia and in every place 1:8*
22. (I Thess. 2:2) Paul and company were treated spitefully at *Philippi*
23. How did Paul describe his gentleness towards the Thessalonians? *as a nursing mother cherishes her own children 2:7*
24. T F When the Thessalonians received the word of God, they welcomed it as the word of men. (I Thess. 2:13) *False*
25. Who hindered Paul from being present with the Thessalonians? *Satan 2:18*
26. T F Timothy brought good news to Paul about the Thessalonians faith and love. *TRUE 2:15*

**Week 50, Wednesday (Dec 9) I Thess 4-5, II Thess 1**

27. Concerning brotherly love", Paul urged that they "aspire to lead a *quiet life, mind your own business, work with your own hands* as we commanded you ..." 4:11
28. Whom did Paul tell the Thessalonians to "esteem very highly in love for their work's sake" (I Thes. 5:12-13)? *the elder s who are over them in the Lord*
29. Paul also said to "warn those who are *unruly* comfort the *fainthearted* uphold the *weak* be patient with *all.*" *5:14*
30. T F The Church of the Thessalonians endured persecutions and tribulations (2 Thess. 1:4). *TRUE*
31. What will happen to those "who do not know God" and those "who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ"? *they will be punished with everlasting destruction 1:8-9*

**Week 50, Thursday (Dec 10) II Thess 2-3, I Tim 1**

32. T F Paul told the Thessalonians the "day of Christ" had already come (2 Thess. 2:2-4). *FALSE*
33. T F Paul told the Thessalonians to continue in the traditions they were taught, whether by word or our epistle. *TRUE 2:15*
34. How did Paul command the Thessalonians to treat the brother who "walks disorderly and not according to the traditions" they had received (2 Thes. 3:6)? *withdraw from them*
35. What specific example(s) of "walking disorderly" did Paul give in 2 Thess. 3:10-12? *not working, busy bodies*
36. Why did Paul urge Timothy to stay in Ephesus? *that he may change some that they teach no other doctrine 1:3*
37. T F The law is made for righteous people. *FALSE 1:9*
38. "Having faith and a good *conscience*, which some having *rejected*, concerning the faith have suffered *shipwreck* of whom are *Hymaneus and Alexander* ." 1:20

**Week 50, Friday (Dec 11) I Tim 2-4**

39. For whom (I Tim. 2:1), should supplications, prayers, intercessions and thanksgiving be made? *all men*
40. In what did Paul say women should adorn themselves? *modest apparel 2:9*

41. What reasons (I Tim. 2:13-14) did Paul give for not permitting women to speak or have authority over a man?  
**Adam was formed first, Eve was deceived**
42. Paul outlines requirements for the position of **bishops (elders)** in I Tim. 3:1-7 and of **deacons** in I Tim. 3:8-13.
43. I Tim. 4:3-4, from which foods should Christians abstain? **none, if it is received with thanksgiving**
44. (I Tim. 4:8) godliness is profitable for **all things,** having promise of the life that **now is** and of that which **is to come.**

**Week 50, Saturday (Dec 12) I Tim 5-6, II Tim 1-2**

45. "Do not rebuke an **older man,** but **exhort** him as a father, younger men as **brothers,** older women as **mothers,** younger as **sisters,** with all **purity** (I Tim. 5:1-2).
46. Anyone who does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, has "denied the **faith** and is worse than an **unbeliever.**" **5:8**
47. T F Paul encouraged younger (than 60) widows to marry and have children. **TRUE 5:14**
48. I Tim. 6:8 - "And having **food and clothing,** , with these we shall be content."
49. The love of money is a root of all kinds of **evil.** **6:10**
50. In 2 Tim. 1:2, Paul calls Timothy a "**beloved son** ."
51. The faith in Timothy dwelt first in his grandmother **Lois** and mother **Eunice.** **1:5**
52. T F "You therefore must not endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ." **FALSE 2:3**
53. This is a faithful saying (2 Tim. 2:11): "For if we **died with Him,** we shall also **live with Him.**"
54. "Be **diligent** to present yourself approved to God, a **worker** who does not need to be **ashamed,** rightly **dividing** the word of truth." 2:14
