### Week 51, Sunday (Dec 13) II Tim 3-4, Titus 1

1. Name the two men who resisted Moses. Jannes and Jambres 3:8,9 (see Ex 7:9-13)
2. Paul told Timothy that "all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution". 3:12
3. "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work 3:16-17.
4. Who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom? the Lord Jesus Christ 4:1
5. T F Paul encouraged Timothy that those with him would always desire to hear the truth. FALSE 4:4
6. To whose impending death does Paul allude in 2 Tim. 24? his own death
7. From whom was Paul delivered, mentioned in 2 Tim. 4:17? the mouth of the lion
8. What did God promise before time began? eternal life Titus 1:2
9. Where did Paul leave Titus? Crete 1:5
10. Why? to set things in order and to appoint elders in every city as Paul had commanded him 1:5
11. Whose mouths did Paul say "must be stopped"? those of the circumcision 1:10

### Week 51, Monday (Dec 14) Titus 2-3, Philem 1

13. Titus 3:1 - "Remind them to be subject to rulers & authorities to obey to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one; to be peaceable, gentle showing all humility to all men. 3:1

15. Who wrote Philemon? Paul and Timothy To whom? Philemon, Apphia, Archippus and "the" church in your house. Phil 1

**Week 51, Wednesday (Dec 16) Heb 4-7**

25. What must "mix with" the gospel to make it profitable for us (Heb 4:2)? *faith 4:2*
26. Who is our "great High Priest"? *Jesus the Son of God 4:14*
27. T F Jesus was tempted in some the same points we are (Heb 4:15). *False 4:15*
28. T F Jesus, though God's Son, learned obedience by the things He suffered (Heb 5:8). *True*
29. Who is the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him? *Jesus 5:9*
