## Dec 27-31

### Week 53, Sunday (Dec 27) Rev 6-8

1. Describe the four horses of Rev. 6 and their riders:

Scripture Ref.	Color	What item in rider's hands	Power given to rider
1 <sup>st</sup> (6:2)	<u>white</u>	<u>bow</u>	<u>Conquering and to conquer</u>
2 <sup>nd</sup> (6:3-4)	<u>Fiery red</u>	<u>sword</u>	<u>To take peace from the earth</u>
3 <sup>rd</sup> (6:5-6)	<u>black</u>	<u>Pair of scales</u>	<u>Over food</u>
4 <sup>th</sup> (6:7-8)	<u>pale</u>	????	<u>Power over 1/4 of the earth; to kill with the sword, with death and by the beasts of the earth</u>

2. When the 5<sup>th</sup> seal was opened, what was given to “those who had been slain for the Word of God and for the testimony which they held” (Rev. 6:11)? a white robe
3. What happened to the earth, sun and moon when the sixth seal was opened? Earth: earthquake  
Sun: black as sackcloth Moon: became like blood 6:12
4. What were the number of all the tribes of the children of Israel who were “sealed” (Rev. 7:4)? 144,000
5. Who stood before the throne and the Lamb in Rev. 7:9? a great multitude (all nations, tribes, peoples and tongues)
6. Who were these people (Rev. 7:14)? the ones who came out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white as snow.
7. What happened after the Lamb opened the 7<sup>th</sup> seal? there was silence in heaven for about 1/2 hour 8:1
8. What happened after each of the 1<sup>st</sup> four angels blew their trumpets? Rev 8

1 <sup>st</sup>	<u>Hail and fire, mingled with blood, they were thrown to the earth. 1/3 of the trees were burned up and all green grass was burned up</u>
2 <sup>nd</sup>	<u>Something like a mountain, burning with fire was thrown into the sea and 1/3 of the sea became blood; 1/3 of sea creatures and 1/3 of ships were destroyed</u>
3 <sup>rd</sup>	<u>Great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch. It fell on 1/3 of the rivers and on the springs of water. 1/3 of water became wormwood and many died because it was bitter</u>
4 <sup>th</sup>	<u>1/3 of the sun, moon, and stars were darkened. 1/3 of the day did not shine, or 1/3 of the night</u>

### Week 53, Monday (Dec 28) Rev 9-12

15. What "would be finished" in the days of the sounding of the 7<sup>th</sup> angel (Rev. 10:7)? the mystery of God
16. About what was John told he "must prophesy again" (Rev. 10:11)? many peoples, nations, tongues, and kings
17. According to Rev. 11:2, how long would Jerusalem be given to the Gentiles to "tread underfoot"? 42 months
18. Who would kill the "two witnesses" and from where would he come (Rev. 11:7)? the beast of the bottomless pit
19. How many died in one day when the two witnesses were called to heaven, and how? 7000, from an earthquake 11:13
20. To whom did the woman give birth in the sign given to John (Rev. 12:4-5)? Jesus
21. Who fought the Dragon and his angels after the child was caught up to God and His throne (Rev. 12:7)? Michael and his angels
22. Who is the Dragon (Rev. 12:9)? Satan
23. What happened to the Dragon and his angels (Rev. 12:9)? they were cast down

**Week 53, Tuesday (Dec 29) Rev 13-15**

24. Who gave the beast his power, his throne and great authority (Rev. 13:2)? the dragon (Satan)
25. Who would worship this beast, according to Rev. 13:8? anyone whose name was not in the Book of Life
26. What "great signs" could the 2<sup>nd</sup> beast perform (Rev. 13:13)? makes fire come down from heaven n the sight of men
27. T F The number of the beast was the number of a man (Rev. 13:18). TRUE
28. Who did John then see standing on Mt. Zion (Rev. 14:1)? Jesus Who was with Him ? 144,000
29. What "great city" did the angel say was "fallen", in Rev. 14:8? Babylon
30. Who did the voice from heaven say would be "blessed" (Rev. 14:13)? those who die in the Lord
31. How much blood came out of the "winepress" that was "trampled outside the city" (Rev. 14:20)? up to the horses' bridles and 1,600 furlongs (200 miles)
32. In Rev. 15, John saw 7 angels having the 7 last plagues in which the "wrath of God is complete". What was given to these angels by one of the 4 living creatures (Rev. 15:7)? 7 golden bowls full of the wrath of God

**Week 53, Wednesday (Dec 30) Rev 16-18**

37. What are the 10 “horns” (Rev. 17:12)? **10 kings**
38. What did the harlot on the beast represent (Rev. 17:18)? **the great city (Babylon)**
39. What would happen “in one day” “in one hour” to that great harlot, Babylon (Rev. 18:8-10)? **death, mourning, famine, fire; king and merchants of the earth will mourn over her**

**Week 53, Thursday (Dec 31) Rev 19-22**

40. After the praises given to God by the “great multitude in heaven”, who made ready to be married (Rev. 19:7-8)? **the Lamb**
41. What did the fine linen marriage garments, clean and bright, represent (Rev. 19:8)? **the righteous acts of the saints**
42. The dragon is identified in Rev. 20:2. Who is he? **Satan**
43. How long is he bound and cast into the bottomless pit (Rev. 20:2-3)? **1,000 years**
44. What will happen to the devil, along with the beast and the false prophet, according to Rev. 20:10? **cast into the lake of fire and brimstone forever and ever**
45. What book was opened in Rev. 20:12? **the Book of Life**
46. Who was cast into the lake of fire (Rev. 20:14-15)? **death, Hades, and anyone not found in the Book of Life**
47. How big was the “new Jerusalem” John saw (Rev. 21:16)? **12,000 cubic furlongs (1,500 cubic miles)**
48. T F There is a very ornate temple in the new Jerusalem (Rev. 21:22). **FALSE**
