### Week 11, Sunday (March 8) Judg 4-7

- 1. After Ehud's death, and after Israel returned to evil, into whose hand did God sell the Israelites? Jaban, King of Canaan For how long? 20 years
- 2. Who was judge in Israel at the time? <u>Deborah</u> Who did she send against Jabin's army? <u>Barak</u> How many and from which tribes came out against Jabin's army? <u>10,000; Naphtali, Zebulun</u>
- 3. Who killed Sisera, commander of Canaan's army, and how? *Jael; drove a peg through his temple*
- 4. How long did the land then have rest? <u>40 years</u>
- 5. How long did Midian prevail against Israel? 7 years
- 6. Whom did the angel of the Lord appoint to be Israel's next judge? <u>*Gideon*</u> Of what tribe was he (Judges 6:15)? <u>*Manasseh*</u> Did he know he was speaking with an angel of the Lord? <u>NO</u>
- 7. Which tribes joined Gideon against the Midianites & Amelekites? \_(Judges 6:35) Asher, Zebulun, Naphtali
- 8. Of the 10,000 who remained, how many were chosen to fight against the Midianites and how were they chosen? <u>300; by how they drank water (putting their hands to their mouths)</u>
- 9. What did Gideon do when he heard the Midianite's dream and it's interpretation? *worshipped*
- 10. With what 3 items were Gideon's soldiers armed? *trumpet, torch, empty pitcher*
- 11. Who killed the Midianites (Judges 7:22)? <u>God</u>

#### Week 11, Monday (March 9) Judg 8-10

- 12. Why did the men of Ephraim reprimand Gideon? <u>*He didn't call them to help fight</u>*</u>
- 13. How many of the Midianites had died (Judges 8:10) by the time Gideon and his 300 men passed through Penuel and Succoth? <u>120,000</u>
- 14. How many more died in Judges 8:12? 15,000
- 15. What did Gideon make with the earrings of the Ishmaelite Midianites? *an ephod* This became a *snare* to Gideon.
- 16. How many sons did Gideon have? <u>70 + 1</u> Who killed the sons of Jerubbaal (Gideon), except Jotham? <u>Abimelech</u>
- 17. Who killed Abimelech and how (Judges 9:53-54)? *his armorbearer;thrust a sword through him*
- 18. Judges 10:1 Who succeeded Abimelech as judge and for how long was he judge? *Tola; 23 years*
- 19. Who was the next judge and how long did he judge? (Judges 10:3) *Jair; 22 years*
- 20. Into whose hands did the Lord deliver Israel? (Judges 10:7) *Philistines & Ammonites*

- 21. Why did Gilead's sons drive out their brother Jephthah? He was the son of a harlot

- 24. What word could the Ephraimite not pronounce correctly? <u>Shibboleth (they pronounced it Sibboleth)</u>
- 25. How many Ephraimites died at the hands of the Gileadites, according to Judges 12:6? <u>42,000</u>
- 26. How long did Jephthah judge Israel? <u>6 years</u>
- 27. Who was his successor and how long did he judge Israel? *Ibzan; 7 years*
- 28. Who was the next judge and how long did he judge Israel? *Elon; 10 years*
- 29. How many sons and grandsons did Abdon son of Hillel have, and how long did he judge Israel? <u>40 sons; 30</u> <u>grandsons; 8 years</u>
- 30. For how long did God deliver Israel into the hands of the Philistines? <u>40 years</u>
- 31. T F Samson was a Nazirite to God "from the womb". <u>TRUE</u>
- 32. What "wondrous thing" did the Angel of the Lord do for Manoah and his wife (Judges 13:20)? *the angel of the Lord ascended in the flame of the altar*

- 38. What did the Philistines do to Samson's wife and her father? *burn them with fire*
- 39. How many Philistines did Samson kill with the Jawbone of a donkey? 1,000
- 40. What was Delilah's promised reward for telling the Philistines the secret of Samson's strength? <u>1100 pieces of silver</u>
- 41. Name the "god" of the Philistines (Judges 16:23): <u>Dagon</u>
- 42. For what was Samson seeking vengeance, in Judges 16:28? *his two eyes*
- 43. What did the Ephraimite Micah take and later return to his mother? <u>1100 shekels of silver</u>
- 44. Judges 17:6 "In those days, there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes".

- 52. How many Benjaminite soldiers were there (Judges 20:15)? 26,000
- 53. Which tribe did the Lord say should be the first to go up against Benjamin? (Judges 20:18) *Judah* How many of these died in the 1st battle? <u>22,000</u> In the 2nd? <u>18,000</u>
- 54. How many of the Benjaminites died in the 3rd and final day of battle with Israel? (Judges 20:35) 25,100
- 55. Who, according to Judges 20:35, defeated Benjamin? *The Lord*
- 56. How many Benjaminite Men were left alive, according to Judges 20:47? 600

### Week 11, Friday (March 13) Judg 21, Ruth 1-2

- 57. What oath had all the Israelite men sworn at Mizpah? <u>None would give their daughter to Benjamin as a wife.</u>
- 58. Who did not join Israel in this oath and in attacking Benjamin? <u>Jabesh Gilead</u> What happened to them? <u>All were destroyed, except 400 virgins</u>
