- 5. Who prophesied to Ahab there would be a 3-year drought (I Kings 17:1)? <u>*Elijah*</u> During the drought, who fed Elijah at the Brook Cherith (I Kings 17:4-6)? <u>*ravens*</u>
- 6. What miracle(s) did Elijah perform for the widow at Zarephath? *your flour and oil will not be used up 17:14*
- 7. What atrocity did Jezebel commit (I Kings 18:4)? *massacred the prophets*
- 8. Who all met with Ahab and Elijah at Mt. Carmel (I Kings 18:19-20)? *all Israel, 450 prophets of Baal and 400 prophets of Ashteroth*
- 9. What was the people's reaction to the fire from the Lord? *fell on their faces 18:39*
- 10. T F Elijah outran a chariot (I Kings 18:45-46). <u>TRUE</u>
