- 39. Psa 118:2 Let Israel, the house of Aaron and all those fear the Lord say: *<u>His mercy endures forever</u>*

- 40. Discussion: Why is it better to put our confidence in the Lord, rather than man? <u>man is fallable, God is not</u>
 <u>118:8</u>
- 41. What/Who is the cornerstone that the builder's rejected and is now the chief cornerstone? <u>Jesus</u>
- 41b. "*This* is the day the LORD has made; We will *rejoice* and be glad in it." *118:22*

Week 27, Friday (Jul 3) Psalm 119-121

Week 27, Saturday (Jul 4) Psalm 122-124
