Week 33, Sunday (Aug 9) Isaiah 38-40

- 1. What specific orders was Hezekiah given when he was sick? <u>set your house in order for you will die 38:2</u>
- 2. Why did God change His mind about Hezekiah's impending death? <u>because of Hezekiah's prayer on how he</u> <u>had been loyal to God 38:3-5</u>
- 3. Where did God "lovingly deliver" Hezekiah's soul? *the pit of corruption38:17*
- 4. To what nation did Hezekiah "show off" the house of his treasures (Isa. 39:2)? *Babylon*
- 5. T F Isaiah was pleased that Hezekiah had shown the visitors the treasure. FALSE 39:6
- 6. T F Hezekiah's sons have a doomed future and he seems to be at peace with it. **TRUE 39:8**
- 7. Who quoted Isa. 40:3 about himself (John 1:23)? *John the baptizer*
- 8. What 2 things can we know about God from Isa. 40:28)? "He neither *faints* nor is *weary*" and "His *understanding* is *unsearchable..*"

Week 33, Monday (Aug 10) Isaiah 41-44

- 9. In Isa. 41:8, Abraham is called God's "*friend*".
- 10. Indeed they *are* all *worthless*; Their works *are nothing* Their molded images *are wind* and *confusion. 41:29*
- 11. Isa 42:1 says that He will bring forth what to the Gentiles? *justice*
- 12. T F The Lord said He had "held His peace" and restrained Himself "a long time" (Isa. 42:14). <u>TRUE</u>
- 13. What did the Lord say (Isa. 42:21) He would exalt and make honorable? *the law*
- 14. Isa 43:1 But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O *Jacob*, And He who formed you, O *Israel*: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called *you* by *your name*; You *are <u>mine</u>*.
- 15. Who does Isaiah 43:20 say will honor God and why? *beast of the field, he gives them drink*
- 16. T F But you have burdened Me with your sins, You have wearied Me with your iniquities. <u>TRUE 43:24</u>
- 17. Isa 44:15, 17 What does the idolatrous craftsman do with the 2 halves of wood? *burns half of it in the fire to eat meat* and *makes carved images*
- 18. T F God "blotted out" the sins of the Israelites (Isa. 44:22). <u>TRUE</u>
- 19. T F The Persian king who decreed the Jews' return to Jerusalem was named by Isaiah hundreds of years earlier (Isa. 44:28, 45:1). *TRUE*

Week 33, Tuesday (Aug 11) Isaiah 45-47

- 20. T F Egyptians and Sabeans would come as servants with the Jewish exiles to Jerusalem, acknowledging their God. <u>*TRUE 45;14</u>*</u>

- 26. Who will save them? *no one* 47:15

Week 33, Wednesday (Aug 12) Isaiah 48-50

- 27. According to Isa. 48:5, why did the Lord declare from the beginning what He would do? <u>So they couldn't</u> <u>say that their idols had done it</u>
- 28. Who will the Lord's arm be against? *the Chaldeans* 48:14
- 29. T F Go forth from Babylon! Flee from the Chaldeans! <u>TRUE 48:20</u>
- 30. Isa 49:13 Why were the mountains to break out in singing? *the Lord has comforted His people and will have mercy on His afflicted.*
- 31. T F The Lord forgot Zion in His anger (Isa. 49:14-15). *FALSE*
- 32. Who "shall bow down to you with *their* faces to the earth, And lick up the dust of your feet." <u>kings</u> <u>and queens</u> <u>49:23</u>
- 33. Isa 50: 2 Why do the fish stink? *there is no water and they die of thirst*
- 34. Let him trust in the name of the *LORD* And rely upon *his God. 50:10*

Week 33, Thursday (Aug 13) Isaiah 51-53

- 35. According to Isa. 51:1-2, who are the "father" and "mother" of those who "follow after righteousness"?
 <u>Abraham & Sarah</u>
- 36. How close is God's righteousness? *<u>near 51:5</u>*
- 37. "*But I am the Lord Your God*, Who divided the sea whose waves roared" <u>51:15</u>
- 38. T F "Zion" made a lot of money when she sold herself. Isa 52 *FALSE 52:3*
- 39. What did God want them to do because they blasphemed every day? *wail* 52:5

- 40. How are the feet of the prophet described? *beautiful upon the mountains* 52:7
- 41. T F The Messiah was to be handsome and brawny, according to Isa. 53:2. FALSE
- 42. For what purpose did the Messiah suffer (Isa. 53:5-6, 8b, 10)? *for our sins*
- 43. T F Isaiah prophesied that the Messiah would suffer and die. <u>TRUE 53:7</u>

Week 33, Friday (Aug 14) Isaiah 54-57

- 44. Isa 54:5 For your *Maker is your <u>husband</u>, the Lord of* Hosts is His name;
- 45. What stones are mentioned in the building of their "building"? *colorful gems; sapphires, rubies, crystal, precious stones* 54:11,12
- 46. Isa. 55:8 says "For My *thoughts* are not your *thoughts*, nor are your *ways* My *ways*."
- 47. What is God's word compared with? *rain and snow 55:10,11*
- 48. "Keep justice, and do *righteousness*, For My *salvation is* about to come, And My *righteousness* to be revealed. 56:1
- 49. According to Isa. 56:7, the House of God "shall be called a house of *prayer* for *all nations.*"
- 50. In Isa 57:13, what will carry the collection of idols away? *wind breath*
- 51. T F The man of God is like the troubled sea. *FALSE 57:20*

Week 33, Saturday (Aug 15) Isaiah 58-60

- 52. Isa 58:2 Yet they seek Me daily, And delight to know *my ways*, As a nation that did *righteousness*, And did not forsake the *ordinance of their God*.
- 53. What is interesting about a spring of water? *it never ceases, they don't fail* 58:11
- 54. According to Isa. 59:2, what separated Israel from God? *iniquities*
- 55. T F We all growl like bears, And moan sadly like doves. Isa 59:11 **TRUE**
- 56. What parts of the "whole armor of God" are mentioned in Isa. 59:17 (see also Eph. 6:14-17)? *breastplate of righteousness, helmet of salvation*
- 57. To whom would the Redeemer come (Isa. 59:20? Those who *turn* from *transgressions* in *Jacob*.
- 58. Isa 60:19 If the sun shall no longer be "your light by day" what will be? *the Lord will be our everlasting light*
