#### Week 34, Sunday (Aug 16) Isaiah 61-63

- 1. Who quoted Isa. 61:1-2 in Luke 4:14-21? <u>Jesus</u> About whom? <u>Himself</u>
- 2. For I, the *Lord*; love *justice*; I hate *robbery* for burnt offering: *61:8*
- 3. What will God cause to spring forth before all nations? *righteousness and praise 61:11*
- 4. In 62:6 who was set on the walls of Jerusalem? *watchman*
- 5. T F God was going to give their grain to their enemies. *False 62:8*
- 6. T F You shall be called sought out, a city not forsaken *True 62:12*
- 7. Isa 63.3 Who had helped tramp the winepress? *no one*
- 8. The people rebelled and grieved who? *His Holy Spirit 63:10*
- 9. Your Holy <u>people</u> have possessed it but a little while; our <u>adversaries</u> have trodden down your sanctuary 63:18

## Week 34, Monday (Aug 17) Isaiah 64-66

- 10. Isa 64:2 Who would tremble at God's presence? *the nations (your adversaries)*

# Week 34, Wednesday (Aug 19) Jer 5-7

- 32. Why did Jeremiah say the people were foolish? Jer 5:4 *They do not know the way of the Lord, the judgment of their God*
- 33. T F The Lord promised to end completely the houses of Israel and Judah (Jer. 5:18). False
- 34. Who prophesied falsely and who ruled by their own power? *prophets priests 5:31*
- 35. Who did the Lord call to flee out of Jerusalem in Jer. 6:1? *children of Benjamin*
