# Week 4, Sunday ("January 18")(Ex 6-8)

Korah and Moses both descended from which son of Levi? *Amram vs 20* Name Aaron's wife *Elisheba* & sons *Nadab, Abihu, Eleazer, Ithamar* 

Name Aaron's grandson by Eleazar: Phinehas vs 25

How old were Moses and Aaron when they spoke to Pharaoh? Moses was 80, Aaron was 83 vs 7

Name the miracles of Moses and Aaron that Pharaoh's magicians could also do: change rod to serpant, turned water to

### blood, brought frogs on to the land

After all the water in Egypt turned to blood, how did the Egyptians get water? dug all around the river vs 24

Could they bring forth lice? Yes No **NO** What did they tell Pharaoh (Ex. 8:19)? *this is the finger of God* When the Lord sent flies into Egypt, whose land remained unaffected? *Israelites vs 22* Why? *God set them apart* Where did Pharaoh tell Moses he could sacrifice to God (8:25)? *in the land of Egypt* 

# Week 4, Monday ("January 19")(Ex 9-11)

When God sent pestilence on the livestock of Egypt, were Goshen's livestock affected? Yes No NO Did Pharaoh know this? Yes No YES

Why did God raise up Pharaoh (Ex. 9:16)? *that God's power will be shown and His name declared* Whose livestock were spared when God sent hailstones & fire in Egypt (Ex. 9:26)? *Israelites (Goshen)* 

Who implored with Pharaoh on behalf of Israel after the promise of locusts (Ex. 10:7)? *Pharoah's servants*How much did the locusts destroy (Ex. 10:15)? *everything (nothing green left)*How dark was the plague of darkness (Ex. 10:21)? *so dark they couldn't see at all* How long was it dark? *3 days*

How did the Egyptians feel about Moses (Ex. 11:3)? he was very great

# Week 4, Tuesday ("January 20")(Ex 12-15)

How were the Israelites to eat the passover meal (Ex. 12:11)? with a belt on their waist, sandals on their feet and a staff in their hand. Eat quickly

Against whom (Ex. 12:12) was God executing judgment at the passover? firstborn of every family

The seven days of the Passover begin with the feast of unleavened bread vs 15

On which of the seven days should there be a holy convocation? first day vs 16

Who was told first that the Israelites would come out of the land where they were oppressed with great possessions

#### (Gen. 15:14)? Abram

How many "men on foot" came out of Egypt (Ex. 12:37)? *about 600,000* 

How long were the Israelites in Egypt? 430 years vs 40

Could a foreigner or stranger keep the Passover (Ex. 12:43,48)? no, unless circucmsized

Whose bones did Moses take with the Israelites? Joseph's 13:19

The Lord led the Israelites in a pillar of *cloud* by day and a pillar of *fire* by night. *vs 21* 

How many Israelites went into battle against the Egyptians (Ex. 14:14)? zero

When the Egyptians pursued the Israelites and went into the Red Sea, how did God complicate matters for them

#### (Ex. 14:25)? He took off their chariot wheels

At about dawn, to where were the Egyptians fleeing (Ex. 14:27)? *the sea* What happened to them? *they drowned* How many of the Egyptian army survived? *none* 

How did the Israelites react (Ex. 14:31)? feared the Lord and believed the Lord and Moses

In Ex. 15:20, what is Miriam, Moses' sister, called? a prophetess

#### Week 4, Wednesday ("January 21")(Ex 16-18)

Against whom did the Israelites complain (Ex. 16:2,8)? MOses and Aaron vs 2 God vs 8

How much manna did the Lord tell the Israelites to gather (Ex. 16:16,22)? one omer per person (approximately 1/10 bushel)

Describe Manna (Ex. 16:31): like wafers made with honey

How long did the Israelites eat Manna? 40 years vs 35

Surely, by now, the Israelites knew that God was in control, right? (Ex. 17:3) Yes No NO

Name the Israelites first foes after the Egyptians: Amelek vs 8

Who led the Israelites in the battle against them? Joshua vs 10

Whom did Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, bring with him to Moses? Zipporah, Moses' wife vs 2

What, according to Ex. 18:21, were the qualifications of the men to judge over thousands, hundreds, fifties and

tens? able men that fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness

#### Week 4, Thursday ("January 22")(Ex 19-21)

Why did God come to Moses in a thick cloud and speak to him in the people's hearing (Ex.19:9)? so the people would

On what mountain did the Lord descend upon in fire with a trumpet sound getting louder and louder? Sinai vs 11

With what two words does God begin the "10 commandments"? "I am" 20:1

About what "class" of people does the Lord give commands in ex. 21:1-7? master/servant

What punishment does God set out for premeditated murder (Ex. 21:12)? death

T or F If a man destroys his servant's eye, his own eye should be destroyed. *FALSE vs 26 servant should be set free* T or F The restitution for offenses committed by animals depended on the prior behavior of the animal. *TRUE vs 28* 

Week 4, Friday ("January 23")(Ex 22-24)

Who saw God, along with Moses, in Ex. 24:9-10? *Aaron, Nadab, Abihu, 70 elders of Israel* Who went with Moses up to the "Mountain of God" (Ex. 24:13)? *Joshua* 

## Week 4, Saturday ("January 24")(Ex 25-28)

Who were the first priests of Israel after the Exodus (Ex. 28:1)? *Aaron, Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, Ithamar* From what tribe (which of Israel's sons) were the first priests (Ex. 2:1)? *Levi* What was engraved on the gold plate that went on the front of Aaron's turban (Ex. 28:36)? *Holiness to the Lord*
