Week 10, Sunday (March 1) Josh 6-8

1. Why was Jericho "securely shut up"? to keep the children of Israel out
2. What happened to Jericho when Israel shouted? the wall fell down
3. What, according to Joshua's curse, would happen to the man who rebuilds Jericho? 1st born and youngest would die
4. What did Achan covet and take? the accursed things (beautiful Babylonian garment, 200 shekels of silver, 50 shekels of gold)
5. Who died with Achan as a result of his sin? his sons, daughters, oxen, donkeys, sheep
6. T F God allowed booty to be taken from Ai. TRUE
7. How many men did Joshua send (the 2nd time) against Ai (Josh. 8:3)? 30,000 The 1st time (Josh. 7:4)? 3,000
8. Josh. 8:25 - How many men and women of Ai died? 12,000
9. What happened to the king of Ai? Joshua hanged him on a tree until evening

15. What mountain area (Josh. 14:13) did Joshua give to Caleb as an inheritance? Hebron

Week 10, Wednesday (March 4) Josh 15-18

16. Josh. 15:8 - What Jebusite city was within Judah's boundaries? Jerusalem
17. What "prize" did Caleb offer to whoever could overtake Kirjath Sepher? Achsah, his daughter Who won the "prize"? Othniel What was his relation to Caleb? nephew And to his new wife (besides "husband") cousin

24. Where was Joshua's inheritance? **Timnath Serah, in the mountains of Ephraim**
25. Name the 6 cities of refuge:
 Canaan: **Kadesh (in Galilee), Shechem, Kiriath Arba**
 East of the Jordan: **Bezer, Ramoth, Golan**

35. Who went with Judah to battle the Canaanites & Perizzites in Judges 1? *Simeon*
36. What did they do to Adoni-Bezek when they caught him? *cut off his thumbs and big toes*
37. Who could Judah not drive out, according to Judges 1:19, and why? *the inhabitants of the low land, they had chariots of iron*
38. In whose inheritance (Judges 1:21) was Jerusalem? *Benjamites*
39. What was God's response (Judges 2:3) to Israel not completely driving out the Canaanites? *they shall be thorns in their sides; their gods will be a snare*
40. Who gave this message to Israel and how did they react? *angel of the Lord, they wept*
41. After Joshua and the leaders of Israel in Joshua's time died, whom did Israel begin to serve (Judges 2:11-13)? *Baals*
42. Who (Judges 2:16) did the Lord raise up to deliver Israel out of the hands of those who plundered them? *judges*
Did Israel listen to them? *NO*
43. Instead of serving God, whom did the Israelites serve? (Judges 3:7) *Baals and Asherahs*
44. Whom did God raise up to deliver Israel from Cushan-Rishathaim? *Othniel, Caleb's nephew*
45. How long did Israel have rest under Othniel? *40 years*
46. How long did Israel serve Eglon king of Moab? *18 years*
47. Whom did the Lord then raise up to deliver Israel? *Ehud, the son of Gera, the Benjamite*

49. Who succeeded Ehud, after Moab was "subdued", as judge (Judges 3:31) and for what is he famous? *Shamgar, the son of Anath; he killed 600 men with an ox goad (a pointed rod used to urge on an animal)*
