- 5. How many noblemen of Belshazzar, Nebuchadnezzar's son, were invited to his feast? 5:1 <u>1000</u>
- 6. What did he then use to drink wine from? gold vessels from the Temple of God 5:3
- 7. Who did they praise while drinking wine? the gods of gold, silver, bronze, iron, wood and stone 5:4
- 8.
