- 3. Why were the herds of cattle groaning and restless? *the fields had been eaten 1:18*
- 4. Is Joel still talking about locusts in Chapter 2? <u>YES 2:25</u>
- 5. With a noise like <u>chariots over mountain</u> they leap, Like the noise of a <u>flaming fire that devours</u> the stubble, Like a strong people set in <u>battle array</u>. 2:5
- 6. Who quoted Joel 2:28-32 in Acts 2:17-21? *Peter*
- 7. T F God would take His time in dealing with Tyre and Sidon. FALSE 3:4
- 8. How were God's people to get their weapons? they beat their plowshares into swords, and pruning hooks into spears 3:10

# Week 40, Thursday (Oct 1) Jonah 1-3

- 32. To where did the Lord tell Jonah to go? <u>Ninevah</u> Why? <u>to cry out against it. their wickedness has come up</u> <u>before Me. 1:2</u>
- 33. Did he immediately go there? Yes No <u>NO 1:3</u>
- 34. Why did Jonah flee to Tarshish (see Jon. 4:2)? <u>I know that you are a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and abundant in loving kindness, One who rrelents from doing harm. 4:2</u>
- 35. What did Jonah do while everyone else on the ship feared for their lives? *took a nap 1:5*
- 36. How did the men come to know that Jonah was the cause of their calamity? *they cast lots* 1:7
- 37. What did the seafarers do after throwing Jonah overboard (Jon. 1:16)? <u>feared the Lord exceedingly and offered a sacrifice to t he Lord and took vows 1:16</u>
- 38. What was significant about the great fish that swallowed Jonah for 3 days and 3 nights? *The Lord had prepared him 1:17*
- 39. How did Jonah escape the great fish? the Lord spoke to the fish and it vomited Jonah onto the dry land 2:10
- 40. How large was the city of Nineveh? *a three day journey 3:3*

- 41. How long before the overthrow of Nineveh? 40 days 3:4

# Week 40, Friday (Oct 2) Jonah 4, Micah 1-2
