### Week 40, Sunday (Sep 27) Joel 1-3

1. About what "great army" of the Lord does Joel prophesy (Joel 1? locusts army 1:4)
2. What does it mean for the "drinkers of new wine to wail"? the vineyards had been eaten 1:4
3. Why were the herds of cattle groaning and restless? the fields had been eaten 1:18
4. Is Joel still talking about locusts in Chapter 2? YES 2:25
5. With a noise like chariots over mountain they leap, Like the noise of a flaming fire that devours the stubble, Like a strong people set in battle array. 2:5
6. Who quoted Joel 2:28-32 in Acts 2:17-21? Peter
7. T F God would take His time in dealing with Tyre and Sidon. FALSE 3:4
8. How were God's people to get their weapons? they beat their plowshares into swords, and pruning hooks into spears 3:10
9. T F And all the brooks of Judah shall be flooded with water; A fountain shall flow from the house of the LORD And water the Valley of Acacias. TRUE 3:18

21. David was an inventor of what? *musical instruments 6:5*
22. Concerning what 2 calamities did the Lord relent in Amos 7:1-6? *locusts, fire 7:1,4*
23. Who did Amos prophesy would die by the sword? *Jereboam 7:11*
24. T F Amaziah encouraged Amos to speak God’s word. *TRUE 7:12*

**Week 40, Wednesday (Sep 30) Amos 8-9, Obe 1**

**Week 40, Thursday (Oct 1) Jonah 1-3**

34. Why did Jonah flee to Tarshish (see Jon. 4:2)? *I know that you are a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and abundant in loving kindness, One who relents from doing harm. 4:2*
35. What did Jonah do while everyone else on the ship feared for their lives? *took a nap 1:5*
36. How did the men come to know that Jonah was the cause of their calamity? *they cast lots 1:7*
37. What did the seafarers do after throwing Jonah overboard (Jon. 1:16)? *feared the Lord exceedingly and offered a sacrifice to the Lord and took vows 1:16*
38. What was significant about the great fish that swallowed Jonah for 3 days and 3 nights? *The Lord had prepared him 1:17*
39. How did Jonah escape the great fish? *the Lord spoke to the fish and it vomited Jonah onto the dry land 2:10*
40. How large was the city of Nineveh? *a three day journey 3:3*

41. How long before the overthrow of Nineveh? 40 days 3:4
42. So the people of Nineveh believed God proclaimed a fast and put on sack cloth from the greatest to the least of them 3:5

**Week 40, Friday (Oct 2) Jonah 4, Micah 1-2**
