Week 43, Sunday (Oct 18) Matt 16-18

1. What did Jesus mean to "beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees? *The doctrine of the Pharisees 16:12*
2. Who did Simon Peter say Jesus was? *You are the Christ the Son of the Living God 16:16*
3. Would it be centuries before the "Son of Man would come in His Kingdom"? Yes No *No 16:28*
4. Describe Jesus at the transfiguration: *His face shown like the sun, His clothes appeared white like a light 17:2*
Who appeared with Jesus? *Moses and Elijah*
5. What did the voice from out of the cloud say? *This is My Beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased. Hear ye Him.* About whom? *Jesus 17:5*
6. Why could Jesus' disciples not cast out the demon? *their unbelief and they needed prayer and fasting 17:20,21*
7. Who is greatest in the kingdom of Heaven? *someone who humbles themselves like a child 18:4*
8. If your brother sins against you, you should: *18:15-17*
