Week 45, Sunday (Dec 6) Phil 2-4

- 1. Paul said that every knee should bow, of those <u>in heaven</u> and of those <u>on earth</u> and of those <u>under</u> the <u>earth</u> 2:10
- 2. He also told the Philippians to "work out your own <u>salvation</u> with <u>fear</u> and <u>trembling 2:12</u>

Week 50, Monday (Dec 7) Col 1-3

- 10. What things were created by and for Christ? *all things 1:16*
- 11. What does Paul say is "Christ's body"? *the church 1:24*
- 12. (Col. 2:10) Christ is the head of all *principality and power*
- 13. What did Christ nail to the cross in Col. 2:14? the handwriting of the requirement that was against us
- 14. What are a shadow of things to come? festivals, new moons, sabbaths 2:16,17
- 15. Where is Christ? above, sitting at the right hand of God 3:1
- What should we put off, since we are a new man? <u>anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language and lying</u> <u>Col 3:8-10</u>
- 17. Whatever we do in word or deed, do all *in the name of the Lord Jesus 3:17*

Week 50, Tuesday (Dec 8) Col 4, I Thess 1-3

- 18. Col. 4:6 "Let your <u>speech</u> always be with <u>grace</u> seasoned with <u>salt</u>, that you may know how you ought to <u>answer</u> each one.

Week 50, Friday (Dec 11) I Tim 2-4

- 42. Paul outlines requirements for the position of *bishops* (*elders*) in I Tim. 3:1-7 and of *deacons* in I Tim. 3:8-13.
- 43. I Tim. 4:3-4, from which foods should Christians abstain? *none*, *if it is received with thanksgiving*
- 44. (I Tim. 4:8) godliness is profitable for *all things*, having promise of the life that *now is* and of that which is *to come*.

Week 50, Saturday (Dec 12) I Tim 5-6, II Tim 1-2
