Week 8, Sunday (February 15) Num 30-32

1. T F A husband or father could overrule a woman's vow. **TRUE**
2. In Num. 31:2, Moses was told to take vengeance on **the Midianites**
3. Whom did Moses allow to be kept alive, among the Midianites? **the young girls who had not known a man intimately**
4. How many sheep did the Israelites capture? **675,000**
5. According to Num. 31:49, how many Israelites died in the battle with the Midianites? **none**
6. How did the army captains respond to this (Num. 31:50)? **They brought an offering for the Lord.**
7. Which tribes requested not to cross the Jordan with Israel? **Gad & Reuben**
8. What was Moses' response? **that they would still have to fight for the land**
9. Half of which tribe joins the other two in Num. 32:33? **Manasseh**

Week 8, Monday (February 16) Num 33-36

10. How old was Aaron when he died? **123 years old**
11. What did God say the Israelites should do to the inhabitants of Canaan? **drive them out** To their engraved stones, molded images and high places? **destroy them**
12. What did God say would happen if the Canaanites were not driven out by Israel? **they would be an irritant to their eyes, a thorn in their sides and will harass them**
13. How many cities of refuge were the Israelites to set aside? **Six** What was the purpose of these cities? **accidental manslayers may flee there** For how long did the manslayer remain in the city of refuge? **until the death of the high priest**
14. How many witnesses were required to condemn a man to death? At least **Two**
15. Did Moses tell Zelophehad's daughters whom they could marry? **YES** If so, whom? **within their father's tribe (Manasseh)** Why? **to keep their inheritance** Did they? **YES**

Week 8, Tuesday (February 17) Deut 1-3

16. How did Moses describe "the wilderness", in Deut. 1:19? **Large; great and terrible**

21. What did Moses say (Deut. 4:6) "is your wisdom and your understanding? **observing the statutes & judgments**
22. What did Moses say the Israelites heard at the foot of Mount Horeb? **a voice**
23. What is God called in Deut. 4:24? **a consuming fire; a jealous God**
24. Moses foretold, in Deut. 4:28, that the Israelites would serve **"gods" made with man's hands**
25. With whom, according to Moses, did God make a covenant at Mount Horeb (Deut 5:2-3)? **Israelites**
26. T F Only Jews' servants could work on the Sabbath. **FALSE**

Week 8, Thursday (February 19) Deut 7-9

27. T F Moses warned the Israelites to destroy all but the women and children of the land of Canaan. **FALSE**

43. What did Moses say every man was doing (Deut. 12:8)? *whatever they wanted*
